Temperature/health screenings before entering the building.




Lunch socially distanced in appropriate space/locations.

# Honor Code

As a nation, community, and school we are in unprecedented times as we navigate the COVID-19 pandemic. Due to these challenges, we have developed an honor code to ensure that we are all doing our part to create a healthy environment for our students, faculty, and staff.

- Parents will immediately and accurately report to school administration a student's contact with anyone the parents know has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or may have symptoms associated with the disease.
- If a student tests positive for COVID-19, that family shall work with school administration and the local health department to contact trace anyone in our school community that could be at risk.
- Parents agree to and shall abide by the updated Illness Policy as well as the Reopening Guidelines.
- Parents understand that these policies will be updated as necessary, and the revisions will be distributed to the parents by email.

By choosing on-campus instruction, you are accepting the terms of the honor code. A failure to abide by the honor code may result in dismissal from school.
