Dear Parents,

Attached is information regarding the start of school and Covid protocols, etc.

Things could change before August 19, and I will keep you informed of any changes.

We will be following these Diocesan recommendations at Blessed Sacrament School. Please read over the guidelines and let me know if you have any questions. I will be available during Registration Week in August to answer any questions. I can also answer you by email, phone, etc.

SOME IMPORTANT POINTS:

*All students will still need to bring a water bottle everyday. Drinking fountains will not be in use.

*Masks are highly recommended for those not fully vaccinated. All students will need a mask for certain events (assemblies, close group work, etc.) All students should have a mask at school each day for times when they may need to be close to others.

*We will be trying to keep students 3 feet apart in desks, lunch, etc. Masking helps prevent the spread of Covid. When students are closer than 3 feet we may ask them to wear a mask.

*Please continue to keep your child home if they are feeling ill. (You were all great last year!) We will not be using the Health App this year, but we ask you to keep the child home if feeling sick or has a fever.

*We will do all we can to keep our school safe. We would like to be in-person all year long again. I have ordered air purifiers for all classrooms. (24 hour purification systems) Some rooms may use desk partitions. Surfaces will be cleaned throughout the day. No classes will be split this year.

*Please sign up for a registration time on the Sign-Up Genius. We can arrange other times if you are not available.

Let me know if you have a problem signing up.

*Mrs. Edelmann, school secretary, will be sending out any information you might need before August 4 regarding registration.

*SCHOOL UNIFORMS: Feel free to check the used uniforms available at Registration. New ones can also be ordered through our uniform company. (All information will be available at Registration.) If wearing gym shoes to school, we ask that they be black or white. (No crazy colors, neon colors, etc.) School shoes are also very acceptable.
